

Evangelism is simply those who know Jesus telling others who don't. It is sharing Who you know and what you know.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be **my witnesses** in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8

There is no one right way to share Jesus with others. Just as each of us are uniquely different as to God's design, so our means of sharing the Good News of the Gospel will vary.

How are you wired to share the Good News?

Scripture is replete with examples of various styles God uses to accomplish His purposes. The most helpful thing about these evangelism styles is learning more about yourself, then you know how God uniquely made you to reach out to others.

- 1. ______ approach—This approach directly confronts individuals with the truth of the Gospel. They proclaim Christ and seek a response. Acts 2:14–41
- 2. _____approach—This

evangelism style engages in reason and dialogue to convince someone of the truth of the Gospel. Acts 17:16–33

3. _____approach—This

evangelism style uses a personal compelling story to

captivate people's attention and communicate truth. John 9:1–34

- 4. ______approach—This approach invests in people and builds relationships, and from that relationship you have the opportunity to share the Gospel. Luke 5:27–31
- 5. _____ approach—This evangelism style is simply inviting people to events or places where they will hear the Gospel message. John 4:1–30
- approach—This approach
 demonstrates love through action rather than mere words
 alone. Acts 9:36–42
