### Judges 7:1–8

#### The Power of God

- God is able to take a \_\_\_\_\_ and make it more than enough.

#### Positioned for God's Power

1. Put your \_\_\_\_\_ and trust in God's ability, not your human ability. (Judges 7:2)
- We are amazing in our ability to take credit for something we have not done.
  - “The more you trust in the arm of the flesh, the less you are going to see the power of God.”—Paul Weber

- “Such confidence as this is ours through Christ before God. Not that we are competent in ourselves to claim anything for ourselves, but our competence comes from God.”  
—2 Corinthians 3:4–5
2. God doesn't need your ability; He needs your \_\_\_\_\_ . (Judges 7:3)
    - When we choose to go our own way and do our own thing we are moving away from God and the power of God that we need.
    - “Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the voice of the Lord? To obey is better than sacrifice and to heed is better than the fat of rams.”  
—1 Samuel 15:22
    - When we follow God's ways, we get God's results.
  3. Worship of God opens the way for the \_\_\_\_\_ of God. (Judges 7:15)
    - When you choose to worship God, you are taking your focus off the circumstance you are facing and setting your focus on our God, who is able.

We serve a God who has no limits. May we live in a way that opens our lives to \_\_\_\_\_ .
