Mark 7:14-15; 17-23

God tells us in Proverbs 4:23 to "guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life." In Jeremiah 17:9 God tells us that "the human heart is deceitful and desperately wicked."

## How do we change what is inside?

- 1. Experience \_\_\_\_\_\_\_(2 Corinthians 5:17 NLT)
- God's Word declares that we become a new person. This truth is the catalyst for our transformation.
- 2. Live with a \_\_\_\_\_ (Philippians 4:8–9) NLT
- As our hearts are being transformed, the things that could defile us will begin to surface. The Holy Spirit will act as a filter to keep our words and actions Christlike.
- 3. Thank God for \_\_\_\_\_ (Romans 5:1–2) NLT
- We will mess up. In our humanity, things will come from within that defile us, but God's grace cleanses and redeems.
- Grace is undeserved. It cannot be earned.

I am so thankful for a God who found me broken and unclean and still chose to send His Son to redeem me.
